

# POUKHANENSE AZALEA



- Plant in morning sun and afternoon shade.
- Rose to lilac-purple flowers in spring. Likes a well-drained, acid soil.
- Good as a foundation, accent, or mass planting

**Pruning:** Prune in spring after the plant is done flowering.

**Fertilizing:** Apply Iron Plus and 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

**Watering:** During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
