

ROSE AZALEA



- Plant in morning sun and afternoon shade.
- Single, deep rose-red flowers in early spring. Glossy green foliage takes on red tints in fall.
- Great as an accent, mass, or foundation planting.

Pruning: Prune in spring after the plant is done flowering.

Fertilizing: Apply Iron Plus and 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
