

TRICOLOR BEECH



- Plant in part shade.
- An attractive purple-leaved form with a distinct cream and pink border. Fall foliage is purple.
- Small shade or specimen tree for small yards.

Spread

Pruning: Prune when dormant in late fall/early spring if needed.

Fertilizing: Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
