- Plant in full sun.
- Foliage is red-maroon, aging to red-dish green. Crimson buds open to bright pinkish-red, single flowers in spring. Fruit is dark red.
- Superb specimen for spring color, wonderful in masses.

Pruning: Prune spring after the tree has flowered if needed.

Fertilizing: Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Also a fall application of Superphosphate will enhance flowering. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
