- Plant in morning sun and afternoon shade.
- This small tree is covered with outstanding white star-like blooms after other white dogwoods. Strawberry-like fall fruits. Red-tinted fall foliage.
- Great as an accent, mass, or specimen tree.

Spread

Pruning: Prune in spring after the tree has flowered if needed.

Fertilizing: Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Also a fall application of Superphosphate will enhance flowering. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
