

BLACK LACE ELDERBERRY



- Plant in full sun to part shade.
- Intense purple black foliage is finely cut, giving it an effect similar to that of Japanese maple.
- Excellent as an accent, mass, or perennial garden planting.


4' - 6'
Height

4' - 5'
Spread

Pruning: Prune the plant down to 6" – 12" in early spring.

Fertilizing: Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
