

BLUE PRINCE HOLLY



- Plant in morning sun/afternoon
- Compact, dense foliage is a lustrous bluish-green. A male (fruitless) form for pollinating other female blue hollies.
- Excellent accent, foundation, or mass planting.

Pruning: Prune in late summer, fall, or early spring as needed.

Fertilizing: Apply Iron Plus and 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
