

# OAKLEAF HYDRANGEA



- Plant in part shade.
- Oak-shaped leaves and large white summer flowers. Excellent wine-red fall color.
- Use as a specimen, accent, or mass planting.




**4' - 6'**  
Height

**3' - 5'**  
Spread

**Pruning:** Prune after flowering because flower buds are set in early fall.

**Fertilizing:** Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Also a fall application of Superphosphate will enhance flowering. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

**Watering:** During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
