

PEE WEE OAKLEAF HYDRANGEA



- Plant in part shade.
- Low mounded habit. Abundant white flower heads in early to midsummer. Wine red autumn foliage.
- Great as an accent, mass, or low border planting.

Pruning: Prune after flowering because flower buds are set in early fall.

Fertilizing: Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
