

TARDIVA HYDRANGEA



- Plant in full sun to part shade.
- Late flowering, large white flower clusters last until frost. Heavy bloomer.
- Excellent as an accent, mass, or shrub border planting.

Spread

Pruning: Prune in late fall/early spring. This hydrangea blooms off new growth.

Fertilizing: Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Also a fall application of Superphosphate will enhance flowering. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
