

HIGASAYAMA JAPANESE MAPLE



- Plant in morning sun and afternoon shade.
- In spring the leaves are a combination of pink, white, and green that fade to green and white in summer. Fall colors are red and orange.
- Great as a specimen in a shady area.

Spread

Pruning: Prune when the tree is dormant in late fall or early spring.

Fertilizing: Fertilize in March/ April with a balanced fertilizer such as 12-12-12. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
