

KOTO NO ITO

JAPANESE MAPLE



- Plant in full sun to part shade.
- A thin leaved maple whose name means 'Harp Strings'. New growth has a large leaf, getting smaller each year. Fall color is a mixture of reds and orange.
- Great as a specimen plant, stunning in mass.

Spread

Pruning: Prune in when dormant in late fall/ early spring if needed.

Fertilizing: Fertilize in March/ April with a balanced fertilizer such as 12-12-12. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
