- Plant in full sun.
- Abundant, large, dark pink, single flowers appear several weeks after most lilacs begin blooming.
- Excellent as an accent, screening, or mass planting.

**Pruning:** Prune after flowering in late spring/summer.

**Fertilizing:** Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Also a fall application of Superphosphate will enhance flowering. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

**Watering:** During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
