- A new variety with an upright, oval form that turns orange and gold in the fall. Excellent shade tree.
- Makes a great shade tree.

Spread

Pruning: Prune when dormant in late fall or early spring.

Fertilizing: Fertilize with 12-12-12 in March/April and again in October/November. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
