- Plant in morning sun/ afternoon shade
- Bright pink blooms appear in mid spring. Evergreen foliage will turn plum-red in winter.
- Good as an accent, mass, or foundation planting.

Spread

Pruning: Prune in spring after the plant is done flowering.

Fertilizing: Apply Iron Plus and 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
