

# MORNING STAR ROSE OF SHARON



- Plant in full sun to part shade
- Medium green foliage holds well into late fall. Double white, red throated blooms in late summer.
- Excellent as a specimen or accent planting




**8' - 10'**

**Pruning:** Prune in late fall/early spring or as needed throughout the year.

**Fertilizing:** Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Also a fall application of Superphosphate will enhance flowering. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

**Watering:** During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
