

FAT ALBERT SPRUCE



- Plant in full sun.
- Rich blue-needles on a fat, dense, pyramidal, dwarf Colorado Spruce.
- An excellent specimen or accent tree.

Spread

Pruning: Prune in spring after new growth emerges or as needed.

Fertilizing: Apply Iron Plus and 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
