- Plant in full sun to part shade.
- Large clusters of highly fragrant, light pink flowers followed by red-dish-black berries.
- Ideal screening, accent, or foundation planting.

Pruning: Prune in late spring/ early summer after the plant has flowered.

Fertilizing: Apply 12-12-12 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November. Also a fall application of Superphosphate will enhance flowering.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
