- Plant in morning sun and afternoon shade.
- Large, deep red leaves which emerge bright red and mature to a deep, rich purple. Fall color is crimson.
- Great specimen, accent, or patio tree.

Spread

Pruning: Prune when dormant in late fall/early spring if needed.

Fertilizing: Fertilize in March/ April with a balanced fertilizer such as 12-12-12. Use Chickity Doo Doo as an Organic alternative to 12-12-12

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
