

LITTLE VOLUNTEER TULIP TREE



- Plant in full sun.
- Yellow tulip-shaped flowers with orange corolla appear in spring. The leaves and tree are 1/3 the size of the species.
- Great for a small shade tree, street tree, or accent tree.
- Will grow **15'** - wide and **20' - 25'** tall

Pruning: Prune when dormant in late fall/early spring if needed.

Fertilizing: Apply 10-10-10 fertilizer in March/April and in October/November.

Watering: During the first year, deeply water plants once a week until the ground freezes in Fall. When watering, let the water slowly soak around the plant. Also remember to use **Root Stimulator** when watering.
