What they look like

Japanese beetle adults are oval, metallic green with bronze-colored wings and are about 1/2" long.

What to look for

- Skeletonized leaves
- From a distance the plant can look like it is dying
- Damage starts from the top of the plant

Susceptible Plants

- Roses
- Rose of Sharon
- Hibiscus
- Linden Trees
- Basil
- River Birch
- Beans
- Japanese Maples
- Willows

How to control

Chemical*

- Eight Insect Control
- Carbaryl Insecticide
- Indoor/Outdoor Insecticide Spray

- All Season's Oil
- Veggie Pharm
